Move-ups for Monday, September 28 must be received not later than 6:00PM on **Monday, September 21** Move-ups for Tuesday and Wednesday close 30 minutes after the end of the trial on previous day. Dogs moved up will be entered at the end of the running order, and every effort will be made to accommodate handlers running multiple dogs in the same class.

It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS: Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Judges reserve the right to measure all dogs without a valid height card. Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division in the Regular program, but not in a lower height division than their proper height division. Handlers must run in their proper height division in the Preferred program.

ENTRY: Entry fee is \$26.00 for the first entry, \$21.00 for Second entry and additional entries of the same dog per day (includes AKC recording fee)

Mail entries, maximum of 10 per envelope, with fees payable to Border Collie Society of America, to Jim Payne, 1139 Mary Jane Lane, Beach Park, IL 60099. Express mail entries **MUST** waive the signature requirement or they will be refused. Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms, and the correct entry fee. Checks returned due to non-sufficient funds will be assessed a \$30.00 fee. All illegible or incomplete forms or those with insufficient entry fees will be returned.

Electronic entries will be accepted. Email your completed and signed entry form to the trial secretary. A Square invoice will be emailed to you (including a 3.3% plus \$0.30 service fee). Once your payment has been received, your entry will be processed. You can download a fillable entry form from this link:

Notification of entry status prior to closing will be emailed to all exhibitors providing an email address. Any exhibitor that does not have an email address should send a SASE or post card to be returned with their entry status information. No other acknowledgement of entry status will be given. Exhibitors with an email address are responsible for making sure their email address is legible and that any email from the trial secretary is not blocked by spam blockers or rejected due to a full mailbox.

Final entry confirmations and judging schedule will be sent after the final closing date to all exhibitors, as per Chapter 1, Section 19 of the regulations for Agility Trials. Exhibitors providing an email address will be emailed their confirmation, exhibitors with no email address or whose email confirmations bounced, will be sent their confirmations via USPS.

WAIT LIST: This club is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the closing date. A maximum of 50 entries will be placed on the wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to closing date, September 2, 2026 at 6:00PM. Any entries withdrawn by September 24, 2026 at 6:00PM will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list and into the trial due to a pulled entry by September 24, 2026 will have their entry and check shredded or voided and returned upon request.

DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW SITE

From North/East/South: Take I-44 to Gray Summit/Hwy 100 Exit 253. Turn east on Hwy 100. After approximately 1/2 mile, turn left on MM at gas station. The new entrance to Purina Farms is approximately 1/2 mile on left, just past herding fields.

From West: Take I-70 to Hwy 47, Exit 193. Take Hwy 47 south to Hwy 100. Continue on Hwy 100 to I-44 east. Take I-44 east one exit to Gray Summit. Follow directions above.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all Border Collies (fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), or an AKC Canine Partners listing number.

Dogs should be physically sound. Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

PRIZES AND AWARDS

Ribbons will be awarded to First Place through Fourth Place in each jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons.

Titles are: GCH, CH, MACH, PACH, Herding Title (PT or above), Obedience title (BN or above) Rally Title (RN or above), Dock Diving, Barn Hunt, Scent Work, UPDog, FETCH, and Fast CAT). - HIT for each category – Rosette and Trophy

Team Championships

Open to any PAIR of Master/Excellent Handler and Dog Teams. A Team MUST have TWO handlers and TWO dogs. A Dog can only be on 1 Team (A handler can be on Multiple teams). Teams can be mixed height and a mixture of Regular and Preferred. Scores will be calculated using Time plus faults. The top 10 teams will participate in a Final Teams relay. More details in scoring will be published in the judging schedule.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee.

The Border Collie Society of America may cancel this event in extreme weather conditions. Entry fees will not be refunded if the trials cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Since bitches in season are not allowed to compete in AKC Agility Trials, the club will refund all but \$5.00 of the entry fee per day for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive written notification of such a claim for refund by letter hand delivered, emailed, or postmarked at least thirty (30) minutes before the trial commences.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$30 returned check fee. No refunds will be issued for overpayment of less than \$10.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

Electronic timing will be used at these trials.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. The Border Collie Society of America has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.

Entries must be made on Official AKC entry forms or copies and must include the signed Agreement and Rules. Junior Handlers must enter their JH# and complete back of form.

Include only AKC titles on entries.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may have made such errors.

No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Errors in entries made by the exhibitor cannot be corrected after the closing date except as noted in this premium list. No refunds for duplicate entries.

Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Agility Trials.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

The Border Collie Society of America does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

Dogs may not be left unattended at the Event Center overnight.

Dogs may not be left in closed vehicles without proper ventilation. If dogs are found in distress, BCSA will take appropriate action.

No professional photography or videotaping is permitted without permission.

The Border Collie Society of America, its Board and Members, and Purina Farms and its employees will not be liable for any loss or injury which may be sustained through disappearance, loss, theft, communicable disease, parasites, injury and/or death of dogs entered in this event.

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Entering for Exhibition Only (FEO)

FEO allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is offered in all classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.

- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Handler has 45 Seconds for Standard, JWW, and Time 2 Beat classes (course time in FAST). Exhibitors must quickly move towards the exit when the horn sounds.
- Dogs may be entered in any level (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring. Toys must be non-audible and may not leave the handlers hand. Cannot be a ball or toy that roll freely may not be used.
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

Fix and Go On

Fix and Go On allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using Fix and Go On will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the run.

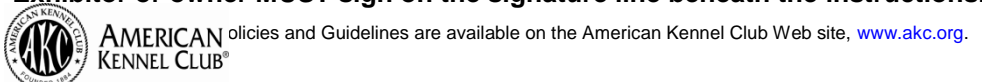
