**DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER:** This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) / Indefinite Listing Privileges (ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners Listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

The AKC is committed to creating a safe and respectful sport environment for all. If you need to talk to someone or need help, please call 800. 656.HOPE (National Sexual Assault Hotline) or text HOME to 741-741 for free, 24/7, confidential services from trained crisis counselors.

**MOVE-UP REGULATIONS:** Dogs may move up to a higher class at the request of the owner as a result of an agility title earned after closing; however, move-up requests must be made in writing and must be received by the Trial Secretary no later than Monday May 4, 2026 at 6:00 pm CST. They may be emailed to [secretary@JPAWSAgility.com](mailto:secretary@JPAWSAgility.com). Provide dog's call name, AKC number, owner's name, original class entered and new class requested. Dogs moved up will generally be placed at the end of the running order.

**ENTRY:** Entry fee is \$25.00 for the first entry, \$20.00 for each additional entry of the same dog per TRIAL per day (includes AKC recording fee). Mail entries, maximum of 10 per envelope, with fees payable to **BSCA** to Jim Payne, 1139 Mary Jane Lane, Beach Park, IL 60099. Express mail entries **MUST** waive the signature requirement or they will be refused. Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms, and the correct entry fee. Checks returned due to non-sufficient funds will be assessed a \$30.00 fee. All illegible or incomplete forms or those with insufficient entry fees will be returned.

Electronic entries will be accepted. Email your completed and signed entry form to the trial secretary. A Square invoice will be emailed to you (including a 3.3% + \$0.30 service fee). Once your payment has been received, your entry will be processed. You can download a fillable entry form from this link:

**CONFIRMATIONS:** Notification of entry status prior to closing will be emailed to all exhibitors providing an email address. Any exhibitor that does not have an email address should send a SASE or post card to be returned with their entry status information. No other acknowledgement of entry status will be given. Exhibitors with an email address are responsible for making sure their email address is legible and that any email from the trial secretary is not blocked by spam blockers or rejected due to a full mailbox.

Final entry confirmations and judging schedule will be sent after the final closing date to all exhibitors, as per Chapter 1, Section 19 of the regulations for Agility Trials. Exhibitors providing an email address will be emailed their confirmation. Exhibitors with no email address or whose email confirmations bounced will be sent their confirmations via USPS.

**MEASURING AND HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION:** Exhibitors are no longer required to submit a copy of their dog's jump height card with their entry or show it the day of the show at check in. It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height card or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running.

**HEIGHT DIVISIONS:** Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Judges reserve the right to measure all dogs without a valid height card. Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division in the Regular program, but not in a lower division than their proper height division. Handlers must run in their proper height division in the Preferred program.

## SITE INFORMATION:

The agility trial will be held at Omaha Sports Complex (14706 Giles Rd, Omaha, NE 68138). It will be indoors on professional-grade soccer turf in a climate controlled building. Two rings measuring 110' x 110' (only one ring will be running at a time). Food will be available on site for purchase. Multiple fast food restaurants are nearby.

Ample crating space will be available. Please use mats underneath all crates. Dogs with space or barking issues should not be crated near the agility field. Crates may be left overnight; however, BSCA, Omaha Sports Complex and JPAWS Agility Trial Services will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site. Dogs may NOT be left overnight.

There is ample parking available in the parking lot around this facility.

**PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOGS!** Potty your dog on the grass immediately around the Omaha Sports Complex Do not allow your dogs to potty on the neighboring businesses grass or green space. Anyone caught not picking up after their dog(s) will be asked to leave without a refund.

**PRIZES AND AWARDS:** Qualifying flat ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Rosettes will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dog in each jump height in each class. Each dog and handler team that finishes an agility title will receive a New Title rosette. MACH and PACH rosettes, along with MACH/PACH bars, will also be awarded to those achieving these titles. All prizes must be claimed the day of the trial, as none will be mailed.

**High In Trial (AM Trial):** Special rosettes work will be awarded to the "High Scoring Belgian Sheepdog with most Qs (regular and preferred) in Standard. A tie will be decided by seconds under regular standard course time. HIT will be awarded based on the following order of consideration:

1. Dog/Handler Team(s) with a score of 100 in Master/Excellent class
2. Dog/Handler Team(s) with a score of 100 in Open class
3. Dog/Handler Team(s) with a qualifying score of less than 100 in open class
4. Dog/Handler Team(s) with a score of 100 in Novice class
5. Dog/Handler Team(s) with a qualifying score of less than 100 in Novice class

In the case of a tie, the award will be given to the dog/handler with most second under standard course time.

**High Combined Regular Classes (AM Trial):** Special rosettes will be awarded for High Combined. All Belgian Sheepdogs competing in both a Regular Standard and Regular Jumpers agility classes, including all jump heights, shall be eligible for the High Combined award. The High Combined award shall be based on qualifying scores from the Regular Standard and Regular Jumpers agility classes. A dog must have Regular Standard and Regular Jumpers qualifying scores to be eligible for the High Combined award. High Combined will be awarded to the dog/handler team with the most points based on the points shown below.

High Combined Points

30 points - Master/Excellent qualifying score

20 points - Open qualifying score

10 points - Novice qualifying score

**High in Trial and High Combined Classes (PM Trial)** Same rewards as AM trial PLUS Stained Wood Belgian Sheepdog Artwork

Should multiple dog/handler teams have an equal number of High Combined Points, High Combined will be determined based on the most combined seconds under course time for both Regular Standard and Regular Jumpers classes. Seconds under course time is calculated based on the course time minus the dog's time for both classes. If multiple dog/handler teams have the most combined seconds under course time, then a run-off will determine High Combined. The course for the run-off is at the agility judge's discretion.

**High Combined Preferred classes:** Same as HC Regular Classes except substitute Preferred for Regular.

**RUNNING ORDER:** Running Order sheets will be posted and will be available online to exhibitors for download after closing. You may print a copy in advance (if desired).

### NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, excused, disqualified, or barred from the competition by action of the Trial Committee. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

The trial giving Club assumes NO responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. Owners/handlers enter at their own risk and agree to assume responsibility for any damage caused by them, their dogs, or their children.

The Club reserves the right to remove any animal in distress from a parked vehicle or crate, and all persons attending this agility trial hereby waive any claim for damages against the Club for such removal.

Bitches that come into season will have their entry fee refunded less a \$12 administrative fee per day. Any dog sustaining an injury after the closing date may have their entry fee returned less a \$12 administrative fee per day. In both cases, the owner must provide the Trial Secretary with written notification at least 30 minutes before judging begins.

Dogs are not required to be at the trial until the scheduled time of judging; however, handlers arriving after the scheduled course walk through for their class has taken place are not guaranteed a chance to walk the course. All dogs not needed for further judging are excused. The owner/handler is solely responsible for being ready at ringside when the class is to be judged.

All dogs must be on a leash no longer than 6' (flexi-leads must be kept under 6') at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated warm-up areas. Exhibitors and spectators are expected to keep the trial site clean. Please pick up after your dogs. Anyone witnessed not picking up after their dog will be excused from the trial weekend with no monies refunded.

Hotels and Campgrounds are an extension of the trial site and expectations are extended from the trial site to the hotels and campgrounds used by our exhibitors.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

### **Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day**

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

### **Entering for Exhibition Only (FEO)**

FEO allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is offered in all classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.

- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Handler has 45 seconds for Time 2 Beat, Standard and JWW classes (course time in FAST). Exhibitors must quickly move towards the exit when the horn sounds.
- Dogs may be entered in any level. If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring. Toys must be non-audible and may not leave the handlers hand. Toys that roll freely may not be used.
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

### **Fix and Go On (FNG)**

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

### **DIRECTIONS:**

Take Exit 440 from I80 west to NE-50 N/S 144<sup>th</sup> St. Continue on NE-50 N/S 144<sup>th</sup> St for about a mile, then turn left on Giles Road. The Sports complex will be on your right.

**WAIT LIST:** The club is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the closing date. A maximum of 50 entries will be placed on the wait list. All entries, including wait-listed entries, must be received by April 16, 2026 at 6:00 pm, will be replaced by a wait-listed entry, if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait-listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait-listed entry that does not move off the wait list and into the trial as a result of a pulled entry by May 3, 2026 will have their entry and check shredded or voided and returned upon request.

**AGREEMENT**

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend, and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons.

I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTREPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.

**INSTRUCTIONS**

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division. All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running. Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners<sup>SM</sup>** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. **Junior Handlers** should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
