DIRECTIONS:

From North/East/South: Take I-44 to Gray Summit/Hwy 100 Exit 253. Turn east on Hwy 100. After approximately 1/2 mile, turn left on MM at gas station. The entrance to Purina Farms is approximately 1/2 mile on left, just past herding fields.

From West: Take I-70 to Hwy 47, Exit 193. Take Hwy 47 south to Hwy 100. Continue on Hwy 100 to I-44 east. Take I-44 east one exit to Gray Summit. Follow directions above.
